## One-Line ESD Protection Low Capacitance Bi-direction TVS

#### **General Description**

AFE1262 are designed by bi-direction TVS diode, to protect high speed data interfaces. This product has been specifically designed to protect sensitive components which are connected to data and transmission lines from overvoltage caused by ESD (electrostatic discharge), CDE (Cable Discharge Events), and EFT (electrical fast transients). The TVS diode prevents over-voltage on the power line, protecting any downstream components. The low capacitance configuration allows the user to protect high-speed data or transmission lines. This device is optimized for ESD protection of portable electronics. They may be used to meet the ESD immunity requirements of IEC 61000-4-2, Level 4 (±15kV air, ±8kV contact discharge).








Fig 1 : Junction Capacitance V.S Reverse Voltage Applied




Fig 2 : Peak Plus Power V.S Exponential Plus Duration




Fig 3 : Clamp Voltage V.S Peak Pulse Current


#### **Device Connection Options**

These TVS diodes are designed to protect one data, I/O, or power supply line. The device is bi-directional and may be used on lines where the signal polarity can go above and below ground.

#### Circuit Board Layout Recommendations for Suppression of ESD.


Good circuit board layout is critical for the suppression of ESD induced transients. The following guidelines are recommended:

- Place the TVS near the input terminals or connectors to restrict transient coupling.
- Minimize the path length between the TVS and the protected line.
- Minimize all conductive loops including power and ground loops.
- The ESD transient return path to ground should be kept as short as possible.
- Never run critical signals near board edges.
- Use ground planes whenever possible.
